Notable Calls in the Village

The information provided below is about some of the call's officers responded to over the last month. Most narratives represent *early* and *preliminary* information that was gathered from those in the field who were actively working the cases. In many instances, facts and circumstances, even the type of crime listed, can change as the investigation unfolds.

02/02: Pursuit/Stolen Vehicle Recovery - 1:24 a.m. Officer observed a reported stolen vehicle on North Sherman Ave. The Officer attempted to stop the vehicle and a vehicle pursuit occurred. The pursuit was terminated due to high speeds. The vehicle was located shortly after the termination and the driver was seen fleeing the vehicle on foot to avoid apprehension. The 56-year-old male suspect was eventually taken into custody and the stolen vehicle was returned to its owner. Charges referred regarding this incident are Resisting Law Enforcement, Possession of Heroin, Possession of Cocaine, Eluding Police, Parole Violation and Possession of schedule 1&2 Narcotics.

02/15: Pursuit – 8:48 a.m. Officer observed traffic/registration violation of a Jeep Liberty at Sherman Avenue and Burrows Road. Traffic stop was attempted, and Jeep refused to pull over resulting in a vehicle pursuit. Officer terminated pursuit due to high speeds and no mutual aid available. Male driver was not identified and the Jeep had no registration plates on it to assist with identification. Investigation still on going.

02/21 Pursuit – 1:56 a.m. Officer assisted Madison PD as mutual aid for a traffic stop on Aberg Ave. During the traffic stop, the vehicle fled the scene at a high rate of speed. A pursuit was initiated but was terminated due to the high speeds. After an investigation, the driver's identity was learned, and charges referred for Eluding and Reckless Endangering Safety.

02/23 Pursuit – 7:41 p.m. Officer attempted a traffic stop in the 300 block of N. Sherman Ave for an equipment violation. The vehicle did not pull over and a pursuit was initiated. Pursuit ended after the driver attempted to flee on foot from the vehicle. The 32-year-old male was taken into custody and had charges referred for Eluding, 2nd degree Reckless Endangerment and Resisting Arrest.
