Notable Calls in the Village

The information provided below is about some of the call's officers responded to over the last month. Most narratives represent *early* and *preliminary* information that was gathered from those in the field who were actively working the cases. In many instances, facts and circumstances, even the type of crime listed, can change as the investigation unfolds.

02/23: Eluding – 7:41p.m. Officer attempted to conduct a traffic stop on a vehicle for an equipment violation. The vehicle refused to stop for the officer and pursuit occurred. The 32-year-old male driver end up abandoning his vehicle and fleeing on foot. Officers were able to take the suspect into custody and place him under arrest for the charges of Eluding, Reckless Endangerment and Resisting/Obstructing a police officer.

03/07: Physical Fight – 12:52p.m. Officer was dispatched to 621 North Sherman Avenue for a physical fight between two males. Officer contacted a 48-year-old male and a 37-year-old male. Citations were issued to both men for Disorderly Conduct and they were released.

03/13: OWI 1st Offense – 12:16a.m. Officer conducted a traffic stop on North Sherman Avenue for a speeding violation. Field sobriety was conducted on the 41-year-old female driver. The driver was arrested for OWI (1st offense) and released to a responsible party.

03/16: Attempted Entry Into M/V – 8:37a.m. Officers were dispatched to Fuller Drive for a subject attempting to enter a unoccupied parked motor vehicle in the driveway of the residence. Upon the officers' arrival, the subject had fled the area. Officers investigated this incident which included home video surveillance from the victim homeowner. The 28-year-old male suspect was later identified by the officers and arrested for Criminal Damage to Property, Attempted Entry into a Motor Vehicle and Trespassing.

03/29: Hit & Run to Parked Vehicle – 1:31p.m. Officers responded to a reported hit and run to a unoccupied parked vehicle in the 100 block of Lakewood Blvd. The investigation is still on going, the suspect vehicle has not yet been identified.

03/30 Forgery – 7:45p.m. Officer was dispatched to the Great China Restaurant at the Lakewood Plaza Shopping Center regarding the use of counterfeit money. Officer investigation was conducted, and suspect was identified by tracing the phone number used to order food to the business. The 52-year-old male suspect currently has a warrant for his arrest through Probation/Parole and our department had forwarded charges to the Dane County DA's Office for Uttering a Forgery.
