Notable Calls in the Village

The information provided below is about some of the call's officers responded to over the last month. Most narratives represent *early* and *preliminary* information that was gathered from those in the field who were actively working the cases. In many instances, facts and circumstances, even the type of crime listed, can change as the investigation unfolds.

08/03: OWI 4th Offense – 11:59pm. Officer made a traffic stop on N. Sherman Avenue for speeding. The officer investigated a suspicion of impairment which resulted in the 37-year-old driver being arrested for Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated (4th offense). Blood alcohol level of the arrested person was .20

08/10: Eluding/Reckless Endangerment – 10:39am. Officer was working the Dane County Stolen Auto Task Force. Officer attempted a traffic stop and vehicle refused to stop resulting in a pursuit. The pursuit was terminated but the suspect vehicle was later found abandoned in a apartment complex parking lot. Madison PD K/9 assisted with track of suspect driver who was eventually located and taken into custody. The 27-year-old male was taken to Dane County Jail on charges of Eluding, Reckless Endangerment, Possession of THC and a parole violation.

08/10: Eluding/Reckless Endangerment – Officers were working the Dane County Stolen Auto Task Force. A 20-year-old-male was arrested for Eluding, Reckless endangerment, Possession With Intent To Deliver THC, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Possession of a Machine Gun, Carrying of a Concealed Weapon and a probation violation. 08/15: Injury Accident, MV/Bicyclist – 8:03am. Officer responded to an injury accident at North Sherman/Lakewood Blvd involving a vehicle and bicyclist. The bicyclist was transported to the hospital and treated for non-life-threatening injuries. The 72-year-old male driver of the vehicle was cited for failure to yield making a left turn.

08/18: Stolen Vehicle/Arrested Person – 4:33am. Officer observed a stolen vehicle on Fordem Avenue. A traffic stop was conducted, and the 20-year-old driver was arrested and taken to Dane County Jail for Operating a Motor Vehicle Without Owner's Consent.
