Notable Calls in the Village of Maple Bluff December 2023



The information provided below is about some of the call's officers responded to over the last month. Most narratives represent *early* and *preliminary* information that was gathered from those in the field who were actively working the cases. In many instances, facts and circumstances, even the type of crime listed, can change as the investigation unfolds.

12/02: Theft – 9:26am. MBPD responded to a report of theft at Ancora Café. A subject had entered the store and took money from the tip jar and then fled away on foot. The suspect in the case has not yet been identified.

12/09: Recovered Stolen Vehicle – 7:03pm. MBPD observed a stolen vehicle at N. Sherman Avenue and Commercial Avenue. A high-risk traffic stop was conducted, and the 46-year-old male driver was taken into custody with the charges of Operating a Motor Vehicle Without Owners Consent and Obstructing Law Enforcement.

12/29: Pursuit/Recovered Stolen Vehicle – 7:15pm. MBPD observed a stolen vehicle at N. Sherman Avenue and Commercial Avenue. MBPD attempted a traffic stop but the vehicle refused to stop, and a pursuit began. The stolen vehicle eventually became disabled, and the driver/passenger fled on foot. Both the driver and passenger were not able to be located and MBPD is still actively investigating this case to identify the two suspects.
