Notable Calls in the Village of Maple Bluff January 2024



The information provided below is about some of the call's officers responded to over the last month. Most narratives represent *early* and *preliminary* information that was gathered from those in the field who were actively working the cases. In many instances, facts and circumstances, even the type of crime listed, can change as the investigation unfolds.

01/07: Eluding/Reckless Endangerment – 11.16pm. MBPD was given information regarding a vehicle not stopping after a traffic stop was initiated by the Madison Police Department. MBPD responded as mutual aid for setting up a tire deflation device and engaged in the pursuit until it was terminated due to weather conditions. The 48-year-old male driver of the vehicle was eventually identified from a follow up investigation from MBPD. The driver has had charges referred to the DA's office for Eluding and Second-Degree Reckless Endangerment.

01/14: Assist Other Agency/Adult Arrest – 2:18am. MBPD responded as mutual aid for the Madison Police Department at Kelly's Market on Shopko Drive regarding a reported intoxicated driver with multiple firearms in his vehicle. MBPD assisted in taking the 24-year-old male driver into custody for OWI. Multiple firearms were also recovered from within the vehicle.

01/16: Assist Other Agency/Adult Arrest – 3:43am. MBPD responded as mutual aid for the Madison Police Department at the area of Aberg/Huxley regarding a driver from a traffic stop that fled on foot. MBPD was able to locate the subject which resulted in the male driver being arrested by Madison PD for fleeing the traffic stop.

01/23: Operating M/V While Intoxicated (3rd Offense) – 11:59pm. MBPD observed a vehicle traveling north on N. Sherman Avenue from the parking lot of the Lakewood Plaza. The vehicle began traveling in the center turn lane and traveled onto the center median where it proceeded to run over a metal traffic sign and then drive back into the north bound lane of traffic. MBPD conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle and after investigating for impairment, the 55-year-old male driver was arrested and taken to Dane County Jail on the charge of Operating While Intoxicated, 3rd offense.

01/27: Eluding/Warrant/Drug Arrest – 7:15pm. MBPD observed a vehicle driving in an unsafe manner on N. Sherman Avenue. The vehicle did not stop for the initiated traffic stop and a short pursuit occurred. The 41-year-old female driver was arrested and taken to Dane County Jail for Eluding, an active arrest warrant, and additionally Madison PD had probable cause to arrest the driver from a child neglect investigation.
