

Village of Maple Bluff Seeking Full-Time Public Works Team Member

The Village of Maple Bluff, Dane County, WI (population 1,411) located on beautiful Lake Mendota, is seeking applicants to fill a full-time Team Member position with our Department of Public Works. A successful applicant should possess our department's core values: Integrity, Compassion, Trust, and Dedication. This is a great opportunity for a self-motivated individual who possesses interpersonal skills and has experience interacting with the public in a professional manner. The ideal applicant should also demonstrate initiative, possess a positive outlook, and have a history of working independently as well as with a team.

General Statement of Duties:

The position is required to work in physically demanding operations and varying weather conditions. Applicants must be capable of lifting 50 lbs.+/- repeatedly and undertaking physically challenging tasks for extended periods of time as related to the operation and maintenance of Public Works duties, equipment, and facilities. Applicants should demonstrate an advanced skill level in working with their hands, power tools, and equipment. All Public Works employees are subject to emergency response call-in for facilities and utilities, extreme weather, and state of emergency operations.

Typical Job Duties:

- Operating a dump truck
- Plowing Snow
- Street and light maintenance
- Park and building maintenance
- Vehicle maintenance (heavy duty dump / garbage trucks, pick-up trucks, skid steer, chipper, and leaf loaders)
- Refuse and yard waste collection
- Stormwater and wastewater infrastructure maintenance
- Landscaping, and tree removal with restoration

This list of duties is not all-inclusive, and other duties are required and assigned as operationally necessary.

Qualifications:

- Must possess a valid Wisconsin Class D driver's license
- Applicants must possess a valid CDL (Class B) driver's license, or the ability to obtain within six months of hire
- Other preferred qualifications:
 - o Experience in Public Works operations
 - o Experience in water/wastewater systems
 - o State of Wisconsin water certifications
 - Strong mechanical skills
 - o Possess a Water operator's license

Pay for this position: Starts at \$23-\$25/hour plus an advanced signing bonus of \$1,000-\$3,000 dependent upon qualifications and a 3% wage increase. The Village of Maple Bluff offers an excellent benefit package to include Wisconsin State Retirement and health/dental/life insurances.
