Village ordinances require the licensing of all dogs and cats, which are at least five months old. Animal licenses are good for a period of one year. All animals in the Village must be registered. Failure to obtain an animal license as required by Wisconsin state law can result in penalties of not less than \$50.00 or more than \$500.00. Wisconsin State Statute 174.07 requires proof of current rabies immunization; please attach a copy from your veterinarian.
