Definitions

Arrest of Wanted / Repeat Offender – Arrests of individuals who were wanted, had an active warrant, or were observed violating conditions of probation, parole, bail, or bond; or had two prior cycles in their record in the past 5 years.

Cases – Refers to investigations initiated based on reported incidents or observed criminal activity. Cases may be open (under investigation), closed (resolved), or referred to a prosecutor for charges.

Cite & Release Arrests – Arrests where the suspect is formally charged and issued a citation but not taken into custody, released at the scene and expected to appear in court at a later date.

Crimes – Defined by statute, a crime is an act that violates local, state, or federal law. Not all incidents involve crimes, and not all crimes result in arrests. Crimes are listed as "serious" or "minor" based on UCR data reporting requirements.

Criminal Charges – The specific offenses that law enforcement files against an individual based on probable cause. One incident may result in multiple charges against one or more individuals.

Incidents – A broad category that includes any event or situation that requires a police response. Not all incidents involve a crime; they can also include property checks, suspicious activity, traffic stops, medical assists, civil disputes, etc.

In-Custody Arrests – Arrests where the suspect is taken into physical custody and transported to jail or another holding facility. These arrests typically involve more serious offenses, active warrants, a flight risk, or a danger to public safety.

Subjects Fleeing MBPD in Car – Vehicle pursuits initiated by the Maple Bluff Police Department (MBPD). It does not include pursuits where MBPD officers assisted another agency but did not initiate the pursuit themselves. A pursuit is initiated when an MBPD officer activates emergency lights and sirens, and the driver fails to stop and actively attempts to evade law enforcement. This data helps track the frequency of vehicle flight incidents and assess enforcement trends.

Stratafied Policing – Targeted, proactive enforcement activities driven by information, observed behavior, and situational risk factors. Stratified policing includes focused traffic enforcement, patrol initiatives, and officer-initiated contacts designed to deter unsafe or criminal activity, identify emerging risks, and prevent more serious incidents before they occur. These activities are distinct from calls for service and reflect intentional deployment strategies rather than reactive response.
