



Notable Calls

Maple Bluff Police Department February 2026

The information provided below summarizes some of the incidents that officers responded to over the past month. Please note that most narratives reflect initial and preliminary details gathered by personnel in the field at the time of the incident. As investigations progress, the facts, circumstances, and even the classification of the incidents may change.

02/01/26: Traffic Arrest (OWI 4st), 6:54PM – An MBPD officer conducted a traffic stop at Sherman Avenue and Commercial Avenue. The investigation resulted in an arrest of the 36-year-old female driver for Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated - 4th Offense.

02/01/26: Traffic Arrest (Probation Violation), 11:35PM – An MBPD officer received information about a stolen vehicle traveling northbound in the 2000 block of Sherman Avenue. The officer located the vehicle near Sherman Avenue and McGuire Street and attempted to initiate a traffic stop. The driver failed to comply with the officer's visual and audible signals, resulting in a vehicle pursuit. The pursuit concluded when the suspect vehicle became disabled. Officers conducted a high-risk stop, and the 26-year-old male driver was taken into custody for Operating a Motor Vehicle Without Owner's Consent. The officer also received information indicating the driver is a suspect in multiple burglaries that occurred earlier this week throughout Dane County.

02/04/26: Traffic Arrest (Stolen Auto), 4:03pm – An MBPD officer received information of a stolen vehicle out of Madison traveling north in the 2000 block of Sherman Avenue. The MBPD officer located the vehicle at Sherman/McGuire Street and attempted to conduct a traffic stop. The vehicle disregarded the officer's visual and audible signals, engaging the officer in a vehicle pursuit. The pursuit ended when the suspect vehicle became disabled. A high-risk stop was conducted, and the 26-year-old male driver was taken into custody for Operating a Motor Vehicle Without Owner's Consent. The MBPD officer additionally received information that the arrested driver was also a suspect in multiple burglaries throughout Dane County that occurred earlier in the week.

02/11/26: Traffic Arrest (Warrant), 7:27PM – An MBPD officer conducted a traffic stop at N. Sherman Avenue and Roxbury Road. The traffic investigation resulted in the arrest of a 35-year-old male driver for a warrant out of Walworth County. The driver was also cited for non-registration of a vehicle.

02/15/26: Assist Other Agency (Weapons Offense), 2:11AM – An MBPD officer was requested as mutual aid from Madison PD regarding a weapons offense in the 1100 block of N. Sherman Avenue. MBPD was first on scene and observed multiple people and vehicles existing in the parking lot. The MBPD officer was able to secure the scene and gather information that the suspect(s) had fled in a vehicle and were last seen traveling east on Aberg Avenue. This information was passed on to the responding Madison PD officers, and no further assistance was provided by our department.

02/25/26: Recovery of Stolen Auto, 7:52pm – An MBPD officer received information of a stolen vehicle out of Madison traveling west in the 1700 block of Commercial Avenue. The MBPD officer located the vehicle being towed by an unmarked tow truck and conducted a traffic stop. The investigation resulted in verification that the vehicle had been reported stolen. The incident was passed on to Madison PD officers, and no further assistance was provided by our department.

02/26/26: Traffic Arrest (Drug Offense), 5:22PM – An MBPD officer conducted a traffic stop at N. Sherman Avenue and Sherman Avenue. The investigation resulted in the arrest of a 62-year-old female driver for Possession of Cocaine and Possession of Drug Paraphrenia.

02/26/26: Traffic Arrest (Eluding), 9:59PM – An MBPD officer attempted to conduct a traffic stop on a vehicle with stolen plates at N. Sherman Ave/Commercial Avenue. The vehicle disregarded the officer's visual and audible signals, engaging the officer in a vehicle pursuit. The pursuit ended when the suspect vehicle became disabled. The 34-year-old-male driver exited and fled on foot, resisted officers' attempts to detain him, and was apprehended with the assistance of an outside agency K9 unit. Three juvenile passengers (ages 14 and 15 years old) were also taken into custody without further incident. Following the arrest, officers confirmed that both the license plate and the vehicle had been reported stolen. Charges including fleeing/eluding an officer, operating a stolen vehicle, reckless endangerment, resisting/obstructing, and related offenses were referred to the Dane County District Attorney's Office for review.

02/27/26: Recovery of Missing Juvenile, 7:35pm – An MBPD officer received information of a missing juvenile out of Stoughton traveling north on North Sherman Avenue. The MBPD officer located the vehicle and conducted a traffic stop. The investigation resulted in the safe reunification of the juvenile with family.
