



Notable Calls

Maple Bluff Police Department March 2026

The information provided below summarizes some of the incidents that officers responded to over the past month. Please note that most narratives reflect initial and preliminary details gathered by personnel in the field at the time of the incident. As investigations progress, the facts, circumstances, and even the classification of the incidents may change.

03/01/26: Assist Other Agency (Traffic Arrest), 1:03AM – An MBPD officer was requested as mutual aid from Madison PD regarding a traffic stop on Huxley/Aberg. The traffic stop investigation resulted in an arrest of the 45-year-old male driver for Bail Jumping and a 29-year-old female passenger for Possession of Fentanyl and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

03/03/26: Traffic Arrest (Warrant Arrest), 1:20AM – An MBPD officer conducted a traffic stop at N. Sherman Avenue and Lakewood Blvd. The traffic investigation resulted in the arrest of a 26-year-old male driver for a warrant out of Dane County for Theft-False Representation.

03/05/26 Assist Other Agency (Burglary), 1:30AM – An MBPD officer was requested as mutual aid from Madison PD regarding a burglary in progress at an apartment on East Mifflin Street. The apartment was cleared by officers and no suspects were located.

03/08/26 Assist Other Agency (Hit & Run/OWI), 9:33PM – An MBPD Officer conducted a traffic stop on a hit and run suspect vehicle that was wanted by Madison PD at 1010 N. Sherman Avenue. Madison PD arrived on scene and arrested the driver for Hit and Run and OWI.

03/17/26: Assist Other Agency (Ice Rescue), 6:05PM – An MBPD officer was requested as mutual aid from Dane County Sheriff/Madison PD regarding two people stuck on Lake Mendota while walking on the ice within distance to the shoreline of Maple Bluff. The MBPD officer was able to locate the couple and lead them safely to shore.

03/19/26: Assist Other Agency (Disturbance), 10:21PM – An MBPD officer was requested as mutual aid from Madison PD regarding a female heard yelling for help and sounds of a physical fight occurring in the 1600 block of Fordem Ave. The area was checked and no person/emergency was located.

03/25/26: Assist Other Agency (Vehicle Accident With Injuries), 11:54PM – An MBPD officer was requested as mutual aid from Madison PD regarding a vehicle versus a motorized scooter at Commercial/Packers Avenue. No injuries were reported and the MBPD officer stood by until traffic was cleared.

03/29/26: Disturbance, 12:52AM – MBPD officers were dispatched to Lakewood Plaza (615 N. Sherman Ave) regarding a reported disturbance. MBPD officers arrived on scene and determined that the disturbance was verbal only and was no longer occurring. Additionally, the primary

03/31/26: Assist Other Agency, 2:29AM – An MBPD officer was requested as mutual aid from the Dane County Sheriff's Office regarding a stolen vehicle that became disabled on Troy Drive and the driver fled on foot. The MBPD officer was able to assist with locating the suspect and placing him under arrest for Operating a Motor Vehicle Without Owner's Consent.
