



Notable Calls

Maple Bluff Police Department May 2026

The information provided below summarizes some of the incidents that officers responded to over the past month. Please note that most narratives reflect initial and preliminary details gathered by personnel in the field at the time of the incident. As investigations progress, the facts, circumstances, and even the classification of the incidents may change.

05/03/2026: Traffic Arrest (Obstructing), 9:03 PM – A MBPD officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle after observing multiple equipment violations in the 600 block of N Sherman Ave. During the traffic stop, the 31-year-old male driver provided a false name to the officer. The male's identity was discovered utilizing an in-squad fingerprinting tool. The male's true identity was revealed, and he was found to be on probation for Substantial Battery, Flee/Elude Officer, Intimidation of a Victim, Theft and Criminal Damage to Property. The male was arrested for Resisting/Obstructing Police as well as a Probation violation. The male was lodged at the Dane County Jail.

05/05/2026: Recovered Stolen Vehicle, Arrested Juveniles, 1:03 AM – A MBPD officer conducting static traffic enforcement in the 600 block of N Sherman Ave observed a silver sedan traveling north on N Sherman at approximately 20 mph over the posted speed limit. The officer noted that 2 occupants in the vehicle were wearing masks, concealing their faces. A traffic stop was conducted on N Sherman near Roth St. Immediately upon coming to a stop, the driver, later identified as a 13-year-old male, and the front seat passenger, also later identified as a 13-year-old male, ran from the vehicle. A 12-year-old female was also in the vehicle. The 12-year-old female stayed with the vehicle and was detained. The MBPD officer discovered that the steering column of the sedan had been tampered with, suggesting it was likely stolen. Follow-up investigation confirmed the vehicle to be stolen through the City of Madison and yielded the names of both males who fled. The male passenger was eventually located near the scene by a law enforcement drone and taken into custody. The male passenger was found to be in possession of the sedan's ignition and was also listed in NCIC as a runaway. The male driver is still outstanding, and probable cause exists to arrest him for Operating a Motor Vehicle Without Owner's Consent and Resisting/Obstructing Police. The female passenger was ultimately released to parents without charges.

05/08/2026: Operating While Intoxicated, Resisting/Obstructing, 7:11 PM – A MBPD Officer observed a vehicle near N Sherman Ave and Sherman Ave with dark window tint. A subsequent query of the license plate on the vehicle revealed that the registered owner, a 26-year-old male, had a warrant through the WI Department of Corrections for the original offense of Operating with Prohibited Alcohol Content (3rd Offense). A traffic stop was conducted on the vehicle, and the male driver provided a fictitious name to the MBPD Officer. Additionally, the male displayed signs of intoxication. The male was confirmed to be the wanted registered owner and was also arrested for Operating While Intoxicated (5th Offense). The male was ultimately lodged at the Dane County Jail on his DOC warrant, OWI 5th, and Resisting/Obstructing Police.

05/09/2026: Recovered Stolen Vehicle, 9:30 AM – A MBPD officer received information from a reliable law enforcement tool that a stolen Nissan SUV had entered the Village on N Sherman Ave near Oxford Pl. The officer located the stolen vehicle, parked and unoccupied, at the Maple Bluff County Club. The vehicle was confirmed stolen through the Whitewater, WI Police Department. While on scene, a male subject was observed walking out to the stolen vehicle and rummaging through it. Contact was made with the male who advised they had just bought the car. Whitewater PD was contacted and advised the vehicle was entered stolen as a caretaker of the registered owner had sold the car without permission. No criminal liability was found with the subject who purchased the car, as they would not have known it was stolen. The male subject was released, and the vehicle was towed at the direction of Whitewater PD.

05/14/2025: Operating While Intoxicated, 11:08 PM – A MBPD Officer on routine patrol at the Maple Bluff Country Club observed a silver SUV leave the parking lot at speeds much higher than typical, drawing the officers attention. The officer then followed the SUV and continued to observe moving violations consistent with an intoxicated driver. After the vehicle disregarded a red light at N Sherman and Aberg, a traffic stop was conducted on the vehicle. The driver was identified as a 62-year-old male. The male showed numerous signs of intoxication and was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated (3rd offense). The male was released to a responsible party after his arrest was processed.

5/19/2026: Warrant arrest, 8:50 PM – A MBPD officer observed a Silver SUV operating with high beams activated on N Sherman near Roxbury. A subsequent query of the license plate revealed the registered owner to not have a valid license. A traffic stop was conducted on the vehicle, and the driver was identified as a 33-year-old male. A NCIC query of the male showed him to have an active warrant through Jefferson County, WI for Operating without a Valid License. The male was taken into custody without incident and lodged at the Dane County Jail.

5/20/2026: Fleeing/Eluding Arrest, Follow Up – MBPD officers continued to conduct follow up regarding a female subject who engaged MBPD officers in a pursuit near Harbort and Warner Dr. on 4/13/2026. On 5/20/2026, it was discovered that the 30-year-old female suspect had turned herself in at the Dane County Jail for her outstanding felony warrant through the WI Department of Corrections. MBPD then processed the arrest of the female for 2nd Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety and Flee/Elude Officer. An attempt was made to interview the female at the jail, however she refused to exit her cell to speak with an MBPD officer.

5/21/2026: Adult Arrested Person, 9:26 PM – A MBPD Officer was called to the 600 block of N Sherman Ave for a welfare check on a potentially intoxicated 28-year-old female subject. During contact with the female, it was discovered she was under the influence of alcohol and had an open felony case in Dane County which restricted her from possessing or consuming alcohol. this violation of bond conditions, the female was arrested and transported to the Dane County Jail without incident.

5/23/2026: Bicycle stop, 3:53 AM – A MBPD officer on routine patrol near Lakewood Blvd and Farwell observed a 38-year-old male subject riding a bike with no lights on and wearing a backpack. The MBPD officer briefly spoke with the male who advised he was lost and trying to get to an address in the City of Madison. The MBPD officer provided directions to the male and ended the contact. Approximately 20 minutes later, the male was then seen again in the 800 block of Kings Way. The MBPD officer then conducted an investigative detention on the male due to his behavior, the time of morning and the fact he had no lights on his bicycle. The male was found to be a convicted, violent felon on active probation through WI Department of Corrections (DOC). The male was warned and directed to exit the Village.

5/27/2026, Resisting/Obstructing, 6:53 PM – A MBPD officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle after observing a tint violation on N Sherman near Oxford Pl. During the traffic stop, the 26-year-old female driver provided her sisters name to the officer when identifying herself. The female's true identity was discovered and she was confronted. The female then admitted her true identity. The female was cited and released on scene for Resisting/Obstructing Police.
