



Notable Calls

Maple Bluff Police Department

July 2026

The information provided below summarizes some of the incidents that officers responded to over the past month. Please note that most narratives reflect initial and preliminary details gathered by personnel in the field at the time of the incident. As investigations progress, the facts, circumstances, and even the classification of the incidents may change.

07/01/26: Juvenile Arrest, Resisting / Obstructing, 5:56 PM – Two MBPD officers were following a vehicle south on Fordem with the intent of making a traffic stop when their attention was drawn to a 12-year-old male juvenile wearing a hooded sweatshirt, ski mask, and latex gloves while walking in the 2000 block of Fordem Ave. Officers noted that it was approximately 91 degrees outside and were aware of multiple recent stolen vehicle incidents in the Fordem Ave corridor. Officers attempted to contact the juvenile based on the totality of these circumstances. The juvenile fled from officers and refused commands to stop. Officers apprehended him following a short foot pursuit. He was lodged in Juvenile Detention for Resisting and Obstructing Police.

07/02/2026: Warrant Arrest, 2:51 PM – A MBPD officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle with no plates near the intersection of Burrows Rd and Sherman Ave. A 44-year-old male passenger was found to have a warrant through the WI Department of Corrections. The male was on probation for offenses involving victim intimidation, drug distribution, and the use of OC spray during a crime. The male was arrested and lodged at the Dane County Jail.

07/02/2026: Warrant Arrest, 12:05 AM – A MBPD officer observed a wanted 40-year-old male in the 600 block of N Sherman Ave. The male had an active warrant for a traffic offense. The male was taken into custody without incident and lodged at the Dane County Jail.

07/04/2026: Pursuit (Terminated) / Assist other Agency, 2:04 AM – A MBPD officer became aware of a vehicle engaging a partner law enforcement agency in a pursuit on I-90 WB near Hwy 30. The officer responded to assist but the pursuit was terminated by the partner agency. Shortly thereafter, the fleeing vehicle was observed traveling approximately 100 mph without headlights on Hwy 30 near Thompson Dr. The officer attempted to stop the vehicle, but the driver continued to flee, engaging the officer in a brief pursuit. The MBPD officer terminated the pursuit due to losing visual contact and the suspect vehicle was later located abandoned on the east side of Madison.

07/04/2026: OWI (Passenger Under 16), Possession of Cocaine, 8:29 PM – A MBPD officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle near N Sherman and Lakewood Blvd for multiple equipment violations. During the stop, the 31-year-old driver was found to be intoxicated. An infant child was also found to be a passenger in the vehicle. The male was arrested for OWI (3rd Offense – Passenger Under 16). The male was also found to be in possession of cocaine and be a self-admitted gang member. The male was lodged at the Dane County Jail.

07/06/2026: Pursuit, Weapons/Drug recovery, 1:43 AM – A MBPD officer was monitoring a bike with no lights entering the Village when their attention drawn to a vehicle operating recklessly near



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905 Huxley in the City of Madison. The officer monitored the vehicle and observed it fail to stop at the stop sign at Huxley and Aberg. The officer attempted a traffic stop on the vehicle. The driver failed to stop and engaged the MBPD officer in a brief vehicle pursuit. The vehicle became disabled after striking a curb and 3 male subjects ran from the vehicle. Two subjects, ages 22 and 28, were apprehended. Officers recovered two handguns and more than 800 grams (nearly two pounds) of THC packaged for distribution from the vehicle. The 22-year-old male was lodged at the Dane County Jail for Flee/Elude, Carry Concealed Weapon and Possession with Intent to Distribute THC. The 28-year-old male was lodged at the Dane County Jail on charges of Felon in Possession of a Firearm, Flee/Elude and Possession with Intent to Distribute THC. The 28-year-old male was found to be on active parole for a federal firearms conviction. The investigation remains active.

07/08/2026: Probation Violation, Weapons Arrest, 10:51 PM – A MBPD officer stopped a vehicle for having a plate displayed which did not return on the vehicle on Pennsylvania near Commercial Ave. The 44-year-old male driver quickly exited the vehicle after being stopped. While in contact with the officer, the male pulled a concealed pocketknife from his rear pants pocket and handed it to the officer. A records check revealed the male to be a convicted felon and to be on probation for Criminal Damage to Property and Entry into a Locked Coin Box. The male was arrested for the weapons violation and lodged at the Dane County Jail.

07/10/2026: Warrant Arrest, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, 1:00 AM – A MBPD officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle near Northfield Pl and N Sherman for displaying plates belonging on another vehicle. The 39-year-old male driver was found to have a warrant through Jefferson County, WI for marijuana possession. The male was also found to be in possession of a crack pipe and was on probation for Possession of Narcotic Drugs. The male was lodged at the Dane County Jail on the warrant, fresh charge and probation hold.

07/11/2026: Suspicious Activity, 8:58 PM – A MBPD officer responded to a residence for sale in the 600 block of Summit Rd for a report of people trespassing. The officer located a 37-year-old female and her juvenile son loitering inside a vehicle in the driveway of the residence. The pair were found to have no fixed address. It was also learned the residence was left unsecured. The female was trespassed from the property and all doors and windows were secured.

07/13/2026: Resisting/Obstructing, 8:06 AM – A MBPD officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for an equipment violation and for an occupant not wearing a seatbelt. Prior to the initial approach to the vehicle, the rear seat occupant, identified as a 40-year-old male, made multiple concerning movements inside the vehicle, causing the officer to believe the male may have accessed or concealed a weapon. The male also appeared to be closely tracking the officers' movements. The male was ordered to exit the vehicle for a weapons frisk and became extremely animated and confrontational. The male was taken to the ground and secured in handcuffs without injury. No weapons were found on his person; however, a folding hunting knife was located next to



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where he was seated inside the vehicle. The male subsequently calmed down and apologized for his behavior. He was cited and released for Resisting and Obstructing Police.

07/13/2026: Warrant Arrest, 7:24 PM – A MBPD officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle after it was observed with extremely dark window tint near N Sherman and Roxbury. A 48-year-old male passenger was found to have an active warrant through Dane County, WI. The male was lodged at the Dane County jail on the warrant.

07/16/2026: Theft from Auto, 10:38 AM – A MBPD officer responded to a report of a male subject who entered the maintenance area of the Maple Bluff Country Club and entered two unlocked vehicles. The male stole cash from both vehicles. The male was scared off by staff and was last observed running across the railroad tracks back into the City of Madison. The suspect has not been identified or arrested as of 8/1/2026.

07/19/2026: Resisting/Obstructing, 2:14 AM – A MBPD officer stopped a vehicle after it failed to stop at a stop sign on Lakewood Blvd at Kensington. During the traffic stop, the 33-year-old driver became disruptive and failed to comply with lawful orders from the officer. With the assistance of Madison PD officers, the female was removed from the vehicle and arrested for Resisting and Obstructing Police. The female was lodged at the Dane County Jail.

07/23/2026: OWI Arrest, 12:58 AM – A MBPD officer observed a motorcycle traveling at a high rate of speed north on N Sherman through the Village. The MBPD officer attempted a traffic stop, but the 27-year-old male motorcyclist failed to yield. The male pulled into a parking lot and attempted to enter an apartment building. The officer apprehended the male and determined that he was impaired. The male was arrested for OWI 1st, Felony Bail Jumping, and Resisting and Obstructing Police. The male was also cited for Failure to Yield/Stop for Officer and Imprudent Speed.

07/26/2026: Pursuit (Terminated), 2:55 PM – A MBPD officer observed a SUV operating well above posted speed limits on Woodland Cir. The officer intercepted the vehicle and found it to be a freshly stolen vehicle from 905 Huxley in the City of Madison. A traffic stop was attempted but the driver chose to engage the officer in a pursuit. As the suspect's driving became increasingly dangerous and traffic conditions increased the risk to the public, the officer terminated the pursuit. Through follow-up investigation, the driver was identified as a 38-year-old male. Probable cause was developed to arrest the male for 2nd Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety and Fleeing/Eluding. Efforts to locate and arrest him remain ongoing.

07/28/2026, Criminal Damage to Property, 10:39 AM – A MBPD officer responded to a complaint of graffiti on a fence facing Sherman Ave. It was discovered that a suspect had caused more than \$1000 in damage using spray paint. The graffiti was political and anti-police in nature. The investigation remains active.
